

Diploma and Diploma Supplement

Upon graduation from the Transport and Telecommunication Institute, a higher education diploma is issued - a state-recognized educational document certifying a person's higher education after completing an internationally accredited study programme according to a certain level of higher education.

In addition to the diploma, the institute's graduate is issued a diploma supplement. The Diploma Supplement follows the model developed by the European Commission, the Council of Europe and the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO / CEPES). The Diploma Supplement is designed to provide objective information and ensure academic and professional recognition of qualifications (e.g. diplomas, certificates).

The Diploma Supplement contains information about the substance, level, context, content and status of the studies successfully completed by the person.

Upon graduation from the Transport and Telecommunication Institute, the Diploma Supplement is issued in Latvian and English.

Diplomas and Diploma Supplements are issued free of charge to each student.

TSI has been awarded the prestigious European Commission Award (Diploma Supplement Label) which certifies that a higher education institution fulfils the conditions for awarding diploma supplements of outstanding quality in accordance with a common European Higher Education Area (EHEA) or the Bologna Process.

The procedure for issuing Diplomas and Diploma Supplements is regulated by the Cabinet of Ministers Regulations No. 202 of 16 April 2013 "Procedures by which state recognized documents certifying higher education are issued" Ministru Kabineta noteikumiem Nr. 202.
